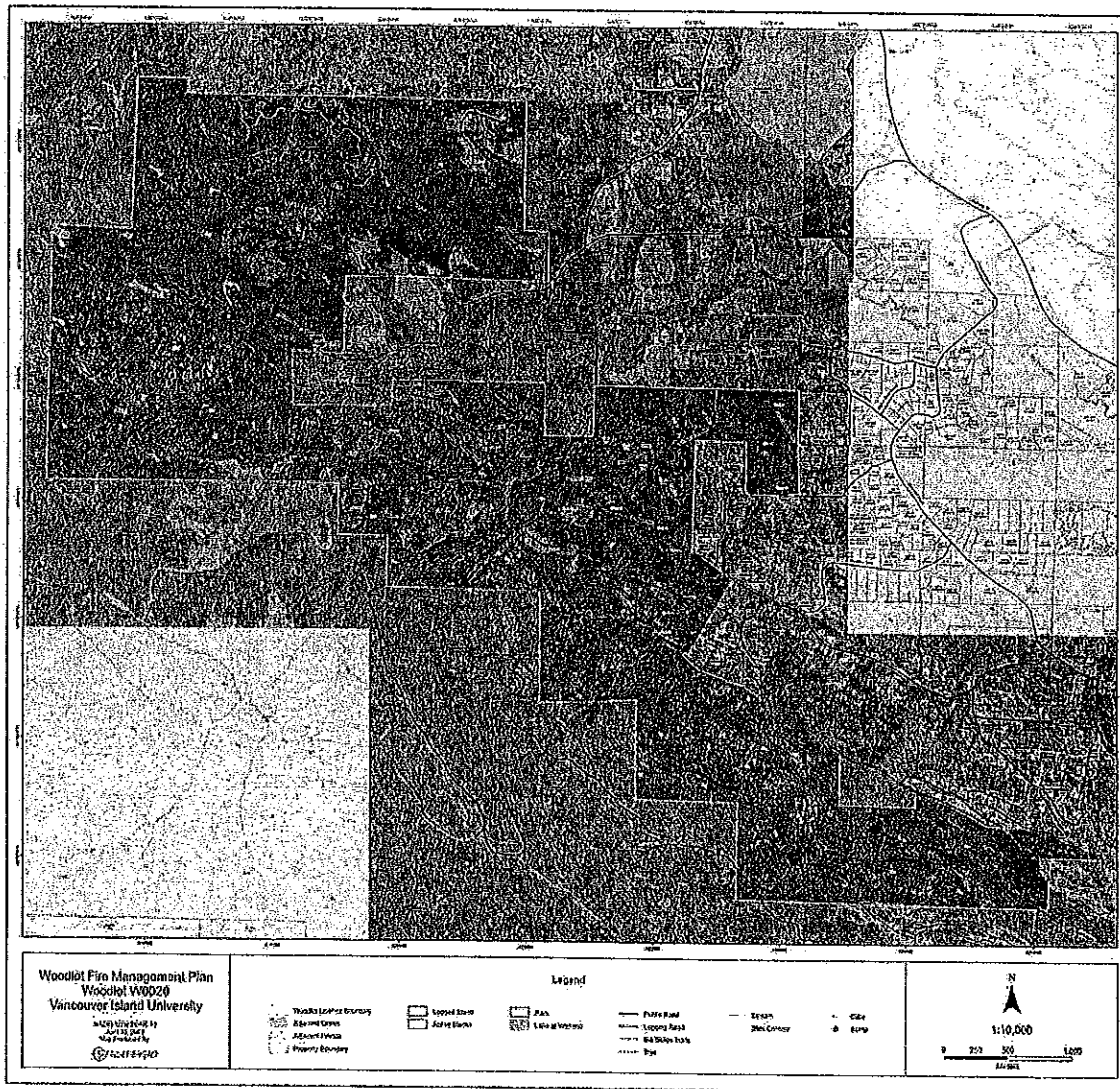

Medical Emergency Procedures

1. Call the appropriate number for emergency help (911 or search and rescue if 911 not available)
2. Be prepared to answer any of the following questions:
 - a. What happened (A brief description)
 - b. Number of injured
 - c. Exact location
 - d. Type of transportation required (Can it be accessed by a vehicle?)
 - e. Is a Billy Pugh/stretchers required?
 - f. Do you need more assistance, oxygen, more first aid equipment?
 - g. Any adverse weather that would complicate a rescue?
 - h. Type and severity of injury
 - i. Chief complaint
 - j. Age and sex
 - k. Name of patient's physician
3. Continue to provide treatment up to the extent of your first aid training until you are relieved by qualified assistance

DO NOT USE FATALY INJURED WORKERS' NAME OVER THE RADIO

Working Alone Procedures

- Establish a partner and check in every hour
- Search must be initiated within 30 minutes if no return contact is received
- If a physical man-search does not locate the person within a further 30 minute search, an intensified search must commence (see emergency contacts)
- A minimum of one (1) daily check-in must be completed with someone outside the crew

Check-in Plan

Notify designated check in attendant (_____)
upon entering and leaving work site. Ensure attendant
knows directions to work site. If contact is not
made after an hour after the established check
out time, a search should be initiated.
