for the purposes of his voyage around the
world ordered by His Majesty, on the
specific condition that he returns the original
documents recorded to the same Archives; I
notify Your Excellency of this in response to
His Majesty's royal order of last February
that prepares the way for it, in order to bring
it to His Majesty's Royal attention.
